Mission:

Who: Remaining Unit members not in the class room training

What: Unit will Conduct a communications and search map production training. All team leaders and OLs will be refreshed on the unit SOP. With emphasis on mission reports.

When: 10am till completion 2/17/08

Where: The Fire Station 52, Gig Harbor, WA. 10 05 31973E 52 36120N. From SR16 exit on the 24th ST Exit. This is the first exit off the bridge. Cross over SR 16. Left on Jahn Ave. one block take a right on Stone Drive. One mile to Point Fosdick road. Take a right the fire station is on the right about ¼ mile ahead.

Why: Starting in March the unit will conduct three mock searches to bring all our new members up to speed on how the unit operates on an actual search. Two mock searches which will be monitored by the Sheriffs Dept. Also the third mock search will be the field qualification test for mounted members upgrading to Field Qualified status.
